I could talk all day about the wonderful inventions developed during my lifetime. But there are other inventions that have also caught my attention. Those annoying (使人烦恼的) creations that perhaps the world could have lived without. For example, voicemail, phone trees and caller hold.

I seem to spend more time talking to recordings than I do people. "Your call is important to me ... leave a message."

I'd feel much more important if you would just answer your phone. I have left messages for friends who tell me they don't even know how to check their voicemail.

But the invention that annoys me the most is when I am required to "push one for this or two for that," when I call a customer service department. Those systems never give anyone the choice to get to an actual person. Then I can't find my way back out.

I don't know how many times I have had to hang up and start over. When I do get to a "real person" they always need to transfer (转接) me to someone else who usually puts me on hold.

I hate being put on hold. It's such a waste of time. The same annoying music repeats over and over, and is interrupted (打断) by a recording, which tries to make me believe that my call is very important.

Somehow I don't feel very important after hearing how important my call is for the 20th time.

I have also called companies when, after getting through an endless menu and finally reaching the correct area, a recording tells me the system already has its maximum (最大的) number of callers on hold. Then it tells me to call back, says goodbye, and hangs up.

They just told me my call was very important — I don't believe them anymore.

Times have changed, and the world seems to be full of so many annoying things. According to my kids, the real problem is that I'm just an old-fashioned guy who doesn't like change.

Cyber bullying (网络霸凌) is a form of bullying but because it happens online or on mobile phones it can happen 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It has destroyed the Mediterranean (地中海)! It is just Caulerpa Taxifolia (杉叶蕨藻), which is not natural to the sea.

Caulerpa usually grows in warm waters such as the Indo-Pacific, Caribbean Sea, and the Red Sea. It has been widely used as a decorative plant in the marine aquarium (海洋水族馆) trade. It can live in cool waters and can survive out of water in wet conditions for up to 10 days.

Caulerpa has been found at depths of less than 1m to 12m in the sea. It was most probably introduced to the sea with the waste water from a marine aquarium and spread to new locations by boating, fishing, swimming and other human activities.

When Caulerpa was first found in the Mediterranean, people believed it would not survive the cold temperatures of the winter. Not so! It grew to bear the cold and in fact it grew fast, affecting 131 kilometers of the coastline of the Mediterranean from Croatia, Italy, Spain, Monaco, France to Tunisia.

Caulerpa competes with other species for space and light, grows rapidly, and sends out toxins (毒素) into the water. It has destroyed the sea life and its communities in the Mediterranean are also being affected by its toxicity. Growth of the "Killer Algae" has also made its way to Australia and California USA.

Caulerpa is very difficult to remove once it has lived in the wild. So it is important to prevent it from entering new waterways. What can we do? Don't throw away aquarium plants. Instead, give them to a responsible aquarium or hobbyist, or store them in cold temperatures for at least 24 hours and then place them in the rubbish.

We only have one earth to live on and everyone has the responsibility to protect our sea. If Caulerpa is discovered in your waters, you should remove it and help save our sea.
